Exhibitors are permitted to bring shavings for personal use, but no fine sawdust allowed. Bedding and hay are available for purchase from VHC Stable Office. Also, please be reminded that participants are required to complete a stall ID card, listing contact information in the event of emergency.

NO horses (including non-competing horses) will be permitted on the grounds unless they have registered prior to arrival with the secretary and submitted a **current negative Coggins test.** You MUST present a copy of your horse's Coggins upon check-in at the stable office. You may also be requested to show a copy of your horse's health certificate if traveling from out of state. <u>Also, you must show documentation of your horse's Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within 6 months of the show.</u>

HEADGEAR RULE FOR DRESSAGE and DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING

From the time horses are officially admitted to the competition grounds by competition management, anyone mounted on a horse at any time on the competition grounds, including non-competing riders, riders on non-competing horses, and those competing in all classes and tests, including Para-Equestrian tests, must wear protective headgear. Handlers, assistant handlers and whip assistants <u>of any age</u> must wear protective headgear while handling or assisting in the competition ring.
