Stall assignments will be posted on the show RE website by Thursday, July 23rd and will also be posted at the show by 9:00 AM on Friday, July 24th. Stall bedding (1 or 2 bags of shavings per stall, depending on whether you have paid for Friday-Sunday or only for day stall) will not be distributed until the arrival day listed on the entry form. The price is: **\$9.00**/bag of shavings. Please email Dianne Boyd with extra shavings orders. Horses should not arrive before Friday morning. Check-in at the show office and schooling starts at Friday noon!

EVERYONE ATTENDING THIS COMPETITION MUST READ and COMPLY WITH the RSD COVID-19 PLAN (ATTACHED). Remember that masks are required upon arrival on the grounds.

The show office will be located in the main coliseum and will be CLOSED to anyone except office staff throughout the show. Office hours: Noon-7pm Friday, 7am-6pm Saturday, 7am-1 hour after show ends on Sunday. Packets can be picked up at tables outside the show office starting at NOON on Friday. There are windows in front of the show office where you can speak remotely to the show secretary if you have questions. However, most communications must be done via email or text.

We will have chips and bottled water at check-in on Friday compliments of Mary Phelps (Markel Insurance), however, there will be no other complimentary hospitality. There will be a food truck on the grounds both Saturday and Sunday mornings through early afternoon.

The N.C. Dept. of Agriculture requires that a copy of a current **NEGATIVE COGGINS** test be available to the State Veterinarian's office for each horse entering the facility. Exhibitors MUST post a copy of the Coggins on the horse's stall door or trailer if you are not stabled. Any equine without a negative Coggins test will immediately be quarantined back to its point of origin. NO horses (including non-competing horses) will be permitted on the grounds unless they have registered prior to arrival with the secretary and submitted a **current negative**Coggins test. Also, you must show documentation of your horse's Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within 6 months of the show.

For those who are driving and using Mapquest or GPS systems for directions, the physical address is: 4601 Trinity Road, Raleigh, NC.

Day parking is allowed around Barn F or between the camper area and Ring 2. Horses will be stabled in Barns B and E. Trailers must be parked in the trailer parking area adjacent to Trinity Road. DO NOT park trailers beside the barns!!

HEADGEAR RULE FOR DRESSAGE and DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING

From the time horses are officially admitted to the competition grounds by competition management, anyone mounted on a horse at any time on the competition grounds, including non-competing riders, riders on non-competing horses, and those competing in all classes and tests, including Para-Equestrian tests, must wear protective headgear. Handlers, assistant handlers and whip assistants <u>of any age</u> must wear protective headgear while handling or assisting in the competition ring.
