

Welcome to RALEIGH SUMMER DRESSAGE I and II

Ride times will be posted on the show website on Tuesday, July 26.

Stall assignments will be posted on the show RE website by Thursday, July 28 and posted at the show by 9:00 AM on Friday, July 29th. Stall bedding will not be distributed until the arrival date on your entry form. The price is: **\$10.00/shavings bag**. Please email Dianne Boyd with shavings orders by Wednesday pm if you want shavings delivered before you arrive. ***Horses may arrive on Friday morning. No check-in (at show office) or schooling before noon!***

Face masks are no longer required except for unvaccinated people who must wear masks inside buildings.

The show office is located in the main coliseum. Office hours: Noon-7pm Friday, 7am-6pm Saturday, 7am-1 hour after show ends on Sunday. **Packets can be picked up starting at NOON on Friday.** We will use the windows in front of the show office for packet pickup and for contact with the office personnel over the weekend.

Chips and bottled water available at check-in compliments of Mary Phelps (Markel Insurance). **Pizza in the Barns:** On Friday evening, look for the golf cart delivering pizza and beverages to the barns around 6:30 pm, sponsored by Rosinburg Events. **Wine and Cheese:** M&M Tack Shop is hosting a FREE PARTY at their shop from 4:00 to 6:00 pm on Saturday. The N.C. Dept. of Agriculture requires that a copy of a current **NEGATIVE COGGINS** test be available to the State Veterinarian's office for each horse entering the facility. Exhibitors **MUST** post a copy of the Coggins on the horse's stall door or trailer if you are not stabled. Any equine without a negative Coggins test will immediately be quarantined back to its point of origin. **NO horses (including non-competing horses) will be permitted on the grounds unless they have registered prior to arrival with the secretary and submitted a current negative Coggins test. Also, you must show documentation of your horse's Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within 6 months of the show.**

For those who are driving and using Mapquest or GPS systems for directions, **the physical address is: 4601 Trinity Road, Raleigh, NC.**

Day parking is allowed around Barn F or between the camper area and Ring 2. Horses will be stabled in Barns B and E. Trailers must be parked in the trailer parking area adjacent to Trinity Road. DO NOT park trailers beside the barns!!

HEADGEAR RULE FOR DRESSAGE and DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING

From the time horses are officially admitted to the competition grounds by competition management, anyone mounted on a horse at any time on the competition grounds, including non-competing riders, riders on non-competing horses, and those competing in all classes and tests, including Para-Equestrian tests, must wear protective headgear. **Handlers, assistant handlers and whip assistants of any age must wear protective headgear while handling or assisting in the competition ring.**

We will use paperless scribing and scoring. Your test sheet will be sent to your email address as soon as your class is finished. Note also that you can check CURRENT ride times (during the show) via a link on the RE website. Check it out.

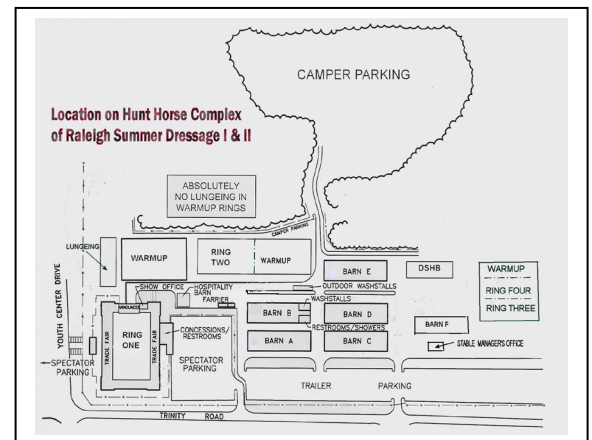
